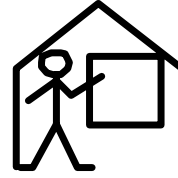

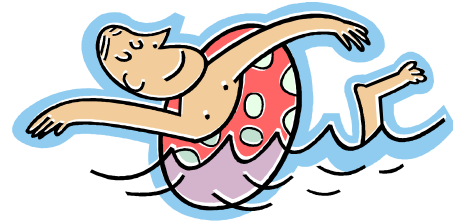
especially when the streamers blew in the wind and the bells rang.
