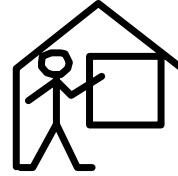


THE REDWAY SCHOOL

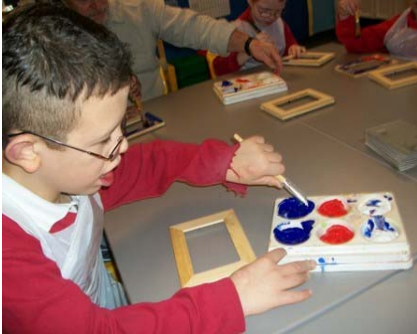


Welcome to Sam and Michelle
