Milton Keynes Council is pleased to announce the annual application process for Short Breaks Vouchers is now open to families with children and young people with a disability and/or those who have additional needs aged up to 25 who have a current Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).

The vouchers can be used for sporting and/or recreational activities. Venues where they can be used are listed in our brochure which we make available to families / carers **once an on-line submission has been received by completing the form at:**

Families / carers are asked to produce ID and sign for the vouchers on collection. Vouchers need to be used by March each year and can only be used for short break activities. They cannot be used for childcare and we are unable to post out vouchers.
